THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD – A



In today's gospel there is sense of fore-shadowing. Jesus was presented by his parents in the templr as part of the purification rite of the observant believers of his day. It seems a lovely tradition to designate as holy to the Lord a family's first-born. But the

encounters with Simeon and the prophet Anna shocked both parents – and fore-shadowed the young boy's future path. These holy people were able to point to the fact that Jesus was the Messiah, and they also revealed just what yhat might mean. According to Simeon's canticle, Jesus was liable to upset the current order. He was destined for the rising and falling of many. His teaching and witness would be a sign that will be opposed. And those who love Jesus would suffer, as Simeon told Mary that a sword will pierce your own soul, too. The challenge in our own faith lives is to accept to love and follow Jesus – even if our journey of faith might demand our purification, or even include sacrifice and suffering with him.


