5th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - A

The gospel text about the beatitudes teaches us that the Christian life has radically different values from the world's. Today Jesus tells his humble followers that they are to be like salt (which is essential to life) and like beacons to the world. But they must remain faithful to Christ's message if they



wish to be saved, their good works done for God's glory, not their own. In the midst of the world their lifestyle must witness to the life-bringing cross. St Paul reminds the Corinthians, those seekers after wisdom, how he had relied only on Christ crucified in his preaching. The power of God was shown in his weakness, not in the logic or eloquence of his arguments. The psalmist pictures the attitudes and deeds of the good person who is a sign to the world. Isaiah lists those good works; sharing our goods as a concrete sign of love for our brothers and sisters, and working to end their oppression, blesses us with God's own presence. With such deeds Christians will be the salt and light of the world!


