

#### **3rd SUNDAY OF LENT- A**

We all long for a full life, for unbroken happiness. Today's gospel tells us that Jesus is as important to our happiness as water is to life. In Jesus' encounter with a sinner and heretic we discover the story of our own conversion from sin. The hardness of our hearts makes us as slow as



the Samaritan woman to admit that material things do not satisfy, and as rebellious as the Israelites in the desert before we come to trust in the Lord. But our unhappiness allows us to experience God's love all the more. Once we ask Jesus for life and admit our sin, we find not shame but liberation to be our best selves. Nor can we contain our joy. We become apostles, as the woman shared her knowledge of Christ. Recognizing Jesus to be saviour brings new life. Ours is not the only thirst. It was Jesus' thirst which brought about the encounter in Samaria, and it is his thirst for a bountiful harvest, his desire to give living water, the indwelling Spirit, which brings us the gift of unending happiness.

#### **CORONAVIRUS** (COVID-19) PREVENTATIVE MEASURES IN PLACE

The Archdiocese of Toronto continues to work with health officials to monitor the local situation regarding active cases of the coronavirus (COVID-19). At this time, Cardinal Collins has asked all parishes to implement the following measures:

1). At the Sign of Peace, refrain from shaking hands - a simple bow, nod or "Peace be with you" to your neighbour is appropriate.

2). For parishes offering communion under both species, forgo the distribution of the Precious Blood from the chalice for the congregation at this time.

3). Parishes should ensure that those distributing communion wash their hands or use hand sanitizer before and after the distribution of communion.

4.) Please also continue to practice healthy hygiene - wash your hands with soap or use hand sanitizer regularly, remain home if you are sick, sneeze/cough into your sleeve and avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth. Let us continue to care for ourselves and one another as we pray for all those impacted worldwide by COVID-19.
