To walk as disciples, the gospel tells us, we must be ready to prefer Jesus to everyone we love and be willing to make ourselves completely available to him. Jesus' road included the cross; his follower cannot shrink from sharing their Master's destiny. But what is the reward? Such

deep communion between disciple and the Lord that whoever receives the one welcomes the other- and the Father who sent his Son, As Christians we have already experienced that union ritually, St. Paul informs us. Our baptism signified immersion in Jesus' death to that we might rise with him. But we must die to sin, renouncing our sinful; inclinations, in order to become alive to God.
