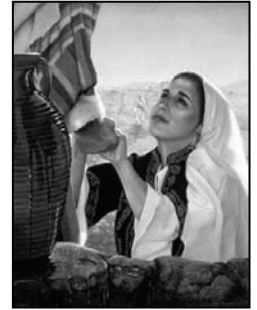

20th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - A

Today’s three readings all take up the same theme: That God wants to save everyone. In Isaiah’s day membership among God’s people included foreigners who observed the holy day and the covenant; one day, political boundaries and racial descent will play no part in distinguishing God’s servants.



God himself will gather together a community of joy and praise. In his letter to the Romans, St. Paul puzzles over the paradox that so many of Jesus’ contemporaries rejected him. But God has turned that tragedy into victory by mercifully reconciling the whole world. The apostle is consoled by the realization that God continues to hold out his gifts to those who have refused them. In today’s gospel, a prayer which is not answered immediately provides a model for our own prayer. The spirited persistence of the pagan woman, who refuses to be excluded from God’s mercy, wins Jesus’ great admiration – and the answer she has demanded in faith. So will we be answered if we ask with faith.

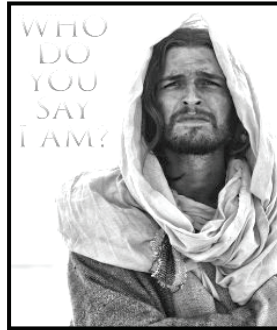

21st SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - A



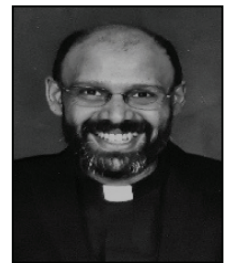
The authority which Jesus gave to Peter and through him to the Church is the subject of today's gospel. Jesus questions his disciples about their understanding of his identity. Solemnly, Simon confesses his faith in Jesus as the Messiah and Son of God. Delighted, but with great seriousness too, Jesus

replies by giving Simon a new name and new function as leader of the Church. He is not to take pride in his faith; it is a free gift of the Father. Jesus speaks of Peter as his rock, and the Church as a city built on this rock which will be victorious over evil. In the power of reconciling or excommunicating (symbolized by the keys), Peter is comparable to the head servant Eliakim in the first reading, who can grant or refuse entrance. Paul's letter to the Romans inspires us to admiration and wonder at the immensity of God's love and the wisdom of his plan in the founding of the Church. The gospels make it clear that Peter was a frail human; yet, through God's power, the community founded on him will endure.

We thank Father Dominic for his many years of ministry to our parish as he moves on to his next assignment. Our parish community will be forever grateful for the wisdom, guidance, and energy that he provided to our parishioners. We pray that the good Lord continue to bless him and keep him in his ongoing efforts to evangelize others through his intellect and eloquence.
