

Forgiveness can be both the easiest and the most difficult thing a person is asked to give. Daily Life is filled with moments in which we ask for forgiveness. Often a simple pardon is granted without much thought: "Don't worry about it" or "No problem" brushes off a

minor transgression. But this may not always be the case, since some moments are not so easily forgotten. Even though forgiveness may be spoken, a person may continue to harbour anger within their heart. In this case, forgiveness has not truly been granted. Some experiences may lead a person to feel so violated that they could never possibly grant a full pardon, even if they so desire it. Sirach reminds us of the damaging effects anger and vengeance can bring to our soul. If anger and vengeance are harboured, they violate our covenant with God. In his letter to the Romans, Paul examines the Lord's sacrifice through which we can all be pardoned. We are subsequently called to do as Christ has done, to forgive those who have trespassed against us. Finally, in Matthew's Gospel we learn that forgiveness is not finite and should never run dry. If it is perpetually poured from all people as it does from the Lord, then the cycle of anger vengeance and hate will come to an end.
