26th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - A

When John the Baptist preached the outcasts of society listened to his message and repented. Now Jesus is preaching, and these same unrespectable people respond to the Good News. The religious leaders object: Aren't they the ones to determine who are the chosen? Is God's mercy to be held out to everyone? After all, they know all the right words to address to God. The parable of the two sons challenges these assumptions, which can be temptations for any religious person. Actions speak to God more loudly than words, Jesus insists. What counts is doing God's will, not empty promises. The first reading makes clear that God's mercy is always available, but we have to accept it. Just as we can never count ourselves as justified in God's eyes, it is never too late to be converted. It is in worshipping together that we become especially aware of God's mercy. Since Christ is our life, we should be united in love and purpose, St. Paul tells us, sharing instead of competing for God's bountiful mercy.
