30th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - A



Does God want love or legalism? In today’s gospel Jesus’ critics set out once more to trap him. They pose a question much disputed at the time. Out of the 613 command-ments the rabbis distinguished, which was the most important? Jesus answers with not one but two commandments

cited from the scriptures. The first, to love God wholeheartedly, was recited twice daily by the devout Jew; the second was part of the Law. Love doesn’t allow for measurement or legalism; it requires the total gift of ourselves. Nor can it be selective; neither commandment can be observed apart from the other. The first reading singles out those among our neighbors for whom God has a special love, as should we: the stranger, the widow, the orphan, the poor. Since these are defenseless, God himself will be their defender. God’s concern shows how we must be sensitive to the needs of others. If love for God and neighbor is the mark of Jesus’ followers, St. Paul observes that Christian joy makes our faith contagious.

First Holy Communion classes will conclude this *Sunday, October 25th at 1:30 pm in the church.* Candidates must attend this meeting.

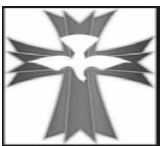

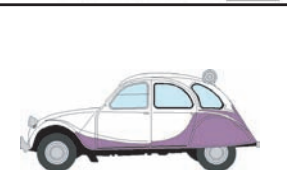
