How hard we humans have tried to build a fitting dwelling place for the Lord God! Today's first reading tells of King David's resolve to build a beautiful temple. But God refuses his

offer. Instead, David's descendants will become the house in which God dwells, and God himself will do the building. The psalm sings gratefully of the Lord's love. But who could have fathomed God's wonderful plan, praised in the concluding hymn of the letter to the Romans? The annunciation story, the liturgy's prelude to Christmas, tells how God took on human flesh. The body of Christ (his human body and his body as Church) becomes the living temple where God is adored. Mary, overshadowed by the Holy Spirit, is the new Ark of the Covenant. When God took the initiative in coming to dwell with humankind, it was a graced individual, Mary, who responded with her ves. She could not know all the implications of her answer, and yet she agreed to God's work in her. Through her son Jesus we are able to offer God perfect worship.




Shorter Office Hours over the holidays – Thursday, Dec 24, 2020
