

FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Never tire of firmly speaking out in defense of life.

Last week we had some good news: the U.S. Supreme Court struck down Roe vs Wade, the notorious 1973 court ruling which had created — out of thin air — a constitutional right to abortion. This new ruling does nothing in itself to limit the taking of innocent human life; rather, the regulation of abortion is now up to individual States. This means that in States such as New York abortions will still be allowed through all nine months of pregnancy, including the killing of healthy full-term babies. Other States will impose various limitations as determined by the State legislatures. This latest court ruling, while a victory for the pro-life movement, does not end the work of promoting the right to life of the most vulnerable persons in our society.

Tragically, the situation in Canada is that abortion is permitted up to the moment of natural birth. We are still completely in the thrall of what Pope John Paul II called the 'culture of death.' As Christians we are called to value every human life from the moment of conception to the moment of natural death. The science is absolutely certain that human life begins at conception. The child in the womb, though totally dependent on his mother for his development, is a separate human being, consisting of body and soul.

As the Catechism states:

The human person, created in the image of God, is a being at once corporeal and spiritual. The unity of soul and body is so profound that one has to consider the soul to be the "form" of the body: spirit and matter, in man, are not two natures united, but rather their union forms a single

In his landmark Encyclical, Evangelium Vitae, 'The Gospel of Life,' Pope John Paul II wrote:

The Gospel of Life is for the whole of human society. To be actively pro-life is to contribute to the renewal of society through the promotion of the common good. It is impossible to further the common good without acknowledging and defending the right to life, upon which all the other inalienable rights of individuals are founded and from which they develop.

A society lacks solid foundations when, human life is devalued and violated, especially where it is weak or marginalized. Only respect for life can be the foundation and guarantee of the most precious and essential goods of society, such as democracy and peace.

Never tire of firmly speaking out in defense of life from its conception and do not be deterred from the commitment to defend the dignity of every human person with courageous determination. Christ is with you: BE NOT AFRAID!
