

FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Cardinal John Henry Newman

He joins the Church of God, not merely who speaks about it, or who defends it, or who contemplates it, but who loves it. — Cardinal Newman

Cardinal Newman's *Apologia Pro Vita Sua* is one of the great works of English literature. It was written in response to a glib accusation by the popular author Charles Kingsley:

Truth, for its own sake, had never been a virtue with the Roman clergy. Father Newman informs us that it need not, and on the whole ought not to be; that cunning is the weapon which Heaven has given to the saints wherewith to withstand the brute male force of the wicked world. Whether his notion be doctrinally correct or not, it is at least historically so.

Kingsley went on to accuse Newman of personally practicing deceit. He claimed that Newman, before his conversion to Catholicism, had been secretly a Catholic while holding a prominent position in the Anglican Church. Newman's friends strongly urged him to publicly refute this slanderous accusation, not for the sake of his own reputation, but to defend the honor of the Catholic Church. He answered the call:

I am bound now as a duty to myself, to the Catholic cause, to the Catholic Priesthood, to give account of myself without any delay, when I am so rudely and circumstantially charged with Untruthfulness. I accept the challenge; I shall do my best to meet it, and I shall be content when I have done so.

Newman's *Apologia* was an intensely personal account of his own conversion: how, as a zealous anti-'Romish' Protestant minister and fellow of Oxford University, he came to question the authority of the Church of England, and eventually, at great personal cost, entered the Catholic Church. The result was that he not only vindicated his own honor and that of the Catholic Church, but he gave the English speaking world a fine piece of literature.

After his conversion, Newman founded the Oratory of St. Philip Neri in Birmingham, a rough industrial city with a large number of poor Irish Catholic immigrants. For the most part, he was busy with humbly serving the needs of his parishioners. Occasionally, however, his intellectual gifts were called into service. Among his most influential works are *The Idea of a University* and *An Essay on the Development of Doctrine*.

Although he is not well known by the average Catholic, Newman is truly one of the most important Catholic writers for our own times. Pope John Paul II and Pope Benedict were both great admirers of Newman. I am not alone in owing Cardinal Newman a great debt of gratitude for the role that he played in my own spiritual journey and in the discernment of my vocation.
