FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Looking forward to what lies ahead.

The Church, which has spread everywhere, even to the ends of the earth, received the faith from the Apostles and now preserves it carefully. Having one soul and one heart, the Church holds this faith, preaches and teaches it consistently as though by a single voice. For though there are different languages, there is but one Tradition. — St. Irenaeus of Lyons.

I have now been at Our Lady of Fatima Shrine for a full year. My appointment was effective June 29th of last year, but my first Mass was on the 28th, the feast day of St. Irenaeus. This Saint has long been a favorite of mine, and as time goes on I find myself drawing closer to him. At a time when our current western culture is increasingly in thrall to anti-Christian ideologies, I admire the example of St. Irenaeus who was such a strong opponent of the Gnostic heresies of his day. The faith that he professed, and defended, is the *exact same faith* that I hold, for as he says, 'there is but one Tradition.' Perhaps it is more than 'coincidence' that my first Mass here was on his feast day.

This past year presented some special challenges, following three years of lockdowns and other restrictions. However, thanks to our great volunteers — those who took on responsibility for Baptism, RCIA, First Communion, and Confirmation programs, our music ministries, our sacristans and altar servers — we managed to get everything done that needed to be done.

Inevitably, every Pastor will have his own preferences with regard to the various options provided in the Roman Missal. You will have noticed that I always do the *Confiteor*; the *Kyrie* is always in *Greek* and *sung*; the Profession of Faith is the *Nicene Creed*; and the Eucharistic Prayer is the *Roman Canon*. As for the use of Latin, the General Instruction on the Roman Missal states: "The main place should be given, all things being equal, to Gregorian chant, as being proper to the Roman Liturgy. It is desirable that they faithful know how to sing together at least some parts of the Mass in Latin according the simpler settings."

When I arrived, I was happy to find that we were singing the *Salve Regina* sometimes at the end of Mass. It is the original Latin version of the 'Hail, Holy Queen' that is said at the end of the Rosary. All clergy sing a 'Marian antiphon' at the end of the day as part of the Liturgy of the Hours. The antiphon varies with the liturgical season, the *Salve Regina* being sung during Ordinary Time. It is a pleasure to be able to sing this with the parish, rather than doing it on my own.

Typically, when a new pastor arrives at the beginning of July he finds the plan for the coming year already worked out. That was not the case last year for obvious reasons. But the schedule for the coming year is now in place, and I am looking forward to what lies ahead.
