#### FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Time is short, eternity is long.

"I know I talk too much, but I am really trying to overcome it, and although I say far too much, yet if you only knew how many things I want to say and don't, you'd give me some credit for it." — Anne of Green Gables, L.M. Montgomery

The Parish calendar runs parallel with the school year. There is a marked lull in activity during the summer and a new start after Labour Day. With fewer parish events to report, we will suspend the printing of the Sunday bulletin until the end August. Any importance announcements will be made at the beginning of Mass.

I will miss writing this weekly column. It is a way for me to discuss some things that do not fit into the homily. Nobody is obligated to read it. I generally do not start my column with a predetermined topic. Rather, I write about whatever is on my mind, whether it relates to the Sunday celebration, to events in the news, or to my current reading.

William Cobbett gave this advice to the aspiring writer: "Sit down to write what you have thought, and not to think what you shall write. If you understand your topic, you will never want thoughts, and thoughts instantly become words."

Cobbett was notorious for his scathing criticisms of the English politics of his day, the early 1800's. He was a master of the art of the rant. The first draft of my column often starts out as a rant against the evils of our own times, in the world and in the Church. There are plenty of things to rant about — don't get me started! However, I have enough good sense to toss the rant into the waste basket and start over. Some criticisms still make it into print, *but if you knew how many things I want to write about and don't, you would give me some credit for it.* 

There is no need for me to add my two cents' worth on every issue. There are many forums for discussion of our current troubles, and there are many good people, modernday prophets, who are able to offer words of wisdom.

St. Paul writes to the Corinthians that "there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit... To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good." Among the gifts, he names wisdom, knowledge, and 'prophecy.' Prophecy is not about predicting the future; it is about directing the people of God back onto the right path when they have gone astray. The prophet shines a light on the current situation and warns of the consequences of foolish and evil actions. The words of the prophet contain 'woes' and 'blessings', depending on whether they are received with repentance or obstinance.

In any case, let us not become overly anxious about current controversies, keeping in mind that 'this too shall pass.' As Cardinal Newman often said, "Time is short; eternity is long."
