FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Life-chain Sunday.

Never tire of firmly speaking out in defense of life from its conception and do not be deterred from the commitment to defend the dignity of every human person with courageous determination. Christ is with you: BE NOT AFRAID! — Pope John Paul II

On 25 March 1995, the Feast of the Annunciation, Pope John Paul II issued his encyclical, *Evangelium Vitae* — *The Gospel of Life: On the Value and Inviolability of Human Life* — calling on all people to uphold a culture of life:

The Second Vatican Council, in a passage which retains all its relevance today, forcefully condemned a number of crimes and attacks against human life. Thirty years later, I repeat that condemnation in the name of the whole Church, certain that I am interpreting the genuine sentiment of every upright conscience: 'Whatever is opposed to life itself, such as any type of murder, genocide, abortion, euthanasia, ... are infamies indeed. They poison human society, and they do more harm to those who practise them than to those who suffer from the injury. Moreover, they are a supreme dishonour to the Creator.'

Since the proclamation of those words, the 'culture of death' has become more deeply entrenched within Western societies. We see this especially in our own nation, where the child in the womb can be killed up to the moment of birth. And this monstrous evil is celebrated as 'reproductive health care' and 'progress in human rights'!

Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn, in reflecting on the atrocities of Soviet ideology, concluded:

I have spent well-nigh 50 years working on the history of our revolution and I have already contributed eight volumes of my own toward the effort of clearing away the rubble left by that upheaval. But if I were asked today to formulate as concisely as possible the main cause of the ruinous revolution that swallowed up our people, I could not put it more accurately than to repeat: 'Men have forgotten God; that's why all this has happened.'

In Germany, during the Second World War, Sophia Scholl was part of a small group of college students who distributed leaflets denouncing the atrocities being committed. They called their group *White Rose*. Sophia was arrested and executed by guillotine on 22 February 1942. She was only 21 years old. When we consider the extent to which we ourselves have embraced a 'culture of death', her words should awaken our consciences:

Who can imagine the extent of the shame that will engulf us and our children once the scales fall from our eyes and crimes monstrous beyond all measure are revealed? — White Rose pamphlet, Germany, 1942
