

## FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

*The Parish Volunteer Screening Program* We fulfill our mission more effectively when we make every effort to ensure a richer, stronger, more vibrant and safer community of faith. — Cardinal Collins

Every organization that relies on volunteers is required to have a process of volunteer screening. The Archdiocese of Toronto launched its screening initiative, called 'Strengthening the Caring Community' over two decades ago. By now, screening should be 'SOP' — 'standard operating procedure' — in every Parish is the archdiocese.

Given the events of the last few years it is not surprising that we have fallen behind in our screening program. Last year we made a good start by putting our screening files in order. It was clear, however, that much of our volunteer data was out of date. For many of our volunteers we have an initial application from twenty years ago and nothing since. In order to ensure that we are up to date, we are asking all of our volunteers to submit a new volunteer registration form. We are also asking the coordinators of our various ministries to submit a current list of members.

As part of the screening program, there is a 'mandatory' requirement that all volunteers (from the least to the greatest) receive training. This consists of a review of the general code of conduct for volunteers, with an additional requirement for dealing with people with disabilities. We are now working on developing a training presentation. Once we get our current volunteers through the training, we will conduct regular sessions for new volunteers

To my way of thinking, there are no 'volunteers' in the Church; rather, we all participate in the life of the Church. Every parishioner ought to be participating in some kind of Parish ministry. This is what Archbishop Leo calls 'stewardship' as he explained in his homily for 'Stewardship Sunday.' There is nothing wrong with just showing up for Mass — after all, it is the Sacraments which are most important — but the Parish is also a community and we should all contribute to the good of the community.

Our current goal is to get our screening program running efficiently and to bring our files up to date. Our Screening Committee has been working hard on this. If you feel that you have the time and the skills to help out, we would be happy to have you join the team.

Some parishioners, especially those who have been active in parish ministry for many years, will find this process to be a nuisance. I agree, but there is no way to avoid it, so let us get it done as efficiently as possible.

Our primary goal is to ensure that our Parish is safe and welcoming. The volunteer screening program is primarily directed to achieving that goal. If you are involved in Parish ministry please take the time to fill out a new registration form. Thank you for your co-operation.
