FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

The 'supreme rule of faith.'

It will not be out of place to consider the ancient tradition, teaching and faith of the Catholic Church, which was revealed by the Lord, proclaimed by the Apostles and guarded by the fathers. For upon this faith the Church is built, and if anyone were to lapse from it, he would no longer be a Christian either in fact or in name. — St. Athanasius

St. Peter Canisius is a 'Doctor of the Church' and one of my great Saints. He was the Superior of the Jesuits in Germany during the Protestant Reformation. The Protestant 'reformers' were publishing attacks on Catholic doctrine at a furious rate, and St. Peter saw an urgent need for a concise Catholic Catechism in the German language. He set about the work with immense care. It was said of that work that it "contains not a single sentence nor hardly even a word that is not from Scripture or the Doctors of the Church. It is not the genius of a particular man that speaks to us here; it is the spirit and the voice of the Church."

The current *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, issued by Pope John Paul II in the early 1990's, is likewise grounded in Scripture and Tradition. This Catechism is not a 'reimagining' of the faith for the 21st Century, but rather a compendium of the authentic Christian faith that has its origin with the Apostles, and which has been handed down through the centuries. Every doctrine of the Catholic Church is traced back to its earliest witnesses. As St. Augustine said of his own predecessors: "They preserved what they found, taught what they learned, and transmitted to their sons what they received from their fathers."

The Second Vatican Council's 'Dogmatic Constitution on Divine Revelation' solemnly declared that Scripture and Tradition together are the 'supreme rule of faith':

Sacred tradition and Sacred Scripture form one sacred deposit of the word of God, committed to the Church. Sacred Tradition takes the word of God entrusted by Christ the Lord and the Holy Spirit to the Apostles, and hands it on to their successors in its full purity, so that led by the light of the Spirit of truth, they may in proclaiming it preserve this word of God faithfully, explain it, and make it more widely known.

St. Athanasius was the great defender of the Catholic faith during the Arian crisis in the 4th century — it is owing to him that we have the Nicene Creed which we recite at Mass every Sunday. The quote at the top of this column is taken from the *Liturgy of the Hours* for Trinity Sunday. It is required reading *every year* by *every Priest and Bishop!* Yet, sadly, there are now many prominent Bishops who consider doctrine 'up for grabs' and have no qualms about ignoring the 'supreme rule of faith.' We know what St. Athanasius would say of them.


