#### FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

The dictatorship of relativism

In 1986 Cardinal Joseph Ratzinger (later to become Pope Benedict XVI) gave a lecture at St. Michaels's College in Toronto. At the time he was the head of the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith working in close collaboration with Pope John Paul II. The theme of the lecture was "The Church as an Essential Dimension of Theology." He was critical of modern theologians who chafed under the constraints of Scripture and Sacred Tradition:

We should recall what Romano Guardini said while he was a student during the modernist crisis and shortly afterward, namely that the Catholicism of his professors was only "liberalism limited by obedience to dogma." Thus, their thought oscillated from side to side. It could not be convincing as liberalism since it was limited by their obedience to dogma, however unwillingly. By the same token, it was not much of a recommendation for Catholicism either since the Church's claim to authority was seen only as chains and fetters, with nothing of its own, nothing positive, nothing alive, nothing grand in it. In such a state of duplicity, their thinking could not endure for long.

Pope Pius X, in his 1907 encyclical *Pascendi* called modernism 'the synthesis of all heresies.' There are now, again, insistent demands for the Church to 'evolve' her doctrine and practice to accommodate secular ideologies. Holding to the primacy of Scripture and Tradition is seen as 'rigidity' or 'backwardism.'

In his homily at the Mass at the start of the conclave which would elect him to succeed Pope John Paul II, Cardinal Ratzinger issued a warning against the watering down of the faith to suit modern secular concerns:

Today, having a clear faith based on the Creed of the Church is often labeled as 'fundamentalism'. Whereas relativism, that is, letting oneself be 'tossed here and there, carried about by every wind of doctrine', seems the only attitude that can cope with modern times. We are building a *dictatorship of relativism* that does not recognize anything as definitive and whose ultimate goal consists solely of one's own ego and desires.

We, however, have a different goal: the Son of God, the true man. He is the measure of true humanism. An 'adult' faith is not a faith that follows the trends of fashion and the latest novelty; a mature adult faith is deeply rooted in friendship with Christ. It is this friendship that opens us up to all that is good and gives us a criterion by which to distinguish the true from the false, and deceit from truth.

We must develop this adult faith; we must guide the flock of Christ to this faith. And it is this faith, and only this faith, that creates unity and is fulfilled in love.





#### To the memory of Fr. Augustine Vella O.C.D.



Rev. Fr. Augustine (Victor) Vella O.C.D. was born in Malta on January 9th, 1949. He was attracted to the hidden life of the young saints of Carmel. So he applied to enter the novitiate with the Discalced Carmelites. In 1966 he made Simple Profession of Religious Vows. Soon

after he was sent for his studies in Philosophy at a seminary in Oxford, U.K. In 1972 he completed his Theological Studies in Malta, and was given the chance to follow a course in Carmelite Spirituality at the TERESIANUM Theological Faculty in Rome. Fr. Augustine was Solemnly Professed in June 1973 and Ordained a Priest on March 15, 1975 for the Archdiocese of Malta.

He was entrusted with various tasks to fulfill in the Province. In 1987 Fr. Augustine was asked to go to Taiwan to help out in the mission. And when in 1996 he returned to Malta he dedicated most of his time to formation of new candidates to the Order, serving as Prior in the various local communities, and dedicating much of his time to various publications and pastoral ministry.

In June 2008 he was appointed 'parish administrator' at Our Lady of Fatima Shrine here in Scarborough. He returned to this parish to fill in for the pastor, Fr. Victor, while the latter was away on vacation. These past few months Fr. Augustine's health began to deteriorate rapidly. At the age of 74 years, on Missions Sunday, October 22nd, 2023, just before 8:00 am, he was called Home to the Father's House to serve in the eternal kingdom.

May he rest in peace. Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord.


