FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Maintenance and Renovation Woes

Throughout the year we have several second collections for the Parish Renovation Fund. These offerings are placed in our 'contingency fund' with the Archdiocese to be used for major maintenance projects.

When I arrived at our Lady of Fatima in July 2022, the rectory was undergoing repairs from a burst water pipe on the second floor. The drywall and carpet in the living room and dining room had to be replaced. Thankfully, our insurance covered the cost.

Another issue was the elevator. It was out of service and beyond repair. One my first acts as Pastor was to sign the contract to install a new elevator. When this Church was built nobody was thinking about accessibility, but now it is an absolute necessity.

On my first tour of the Church I was impressed by the amount of usable space. The rectory, for example has four suites (consisting of sitting room, bedroom and bathroom) plus one bedroom with bathroom. Fr. Bernard was using the 'housekeeper's suite' on the ground floor. The upstairs was not being used at all. I moved into one of the upstairs suites.

The large master suite has since been painted and carpeted, and is now furnished with my Mom's bedroom set. The small room also has a bed and bureau from my Mom's house. The last suite still has some of Fr. Robson's things in it. Once those are removed, with new paint and carpet, it will make another room for guests or, perhaps, a retired priest in residence.

The hall itself is a great space, but the kitchen and washrooms need to be brought up to a minimum modern standard. The first step was to get the washrooms fully functional. In the men's room both toilets and one urinal were out of order, and one toilet in the women's room.

This week we brought in a plumber to replace all the flushers in the gents' and one in the ladies'. However, the new flushers could not be fitted to the old toilets, which meant installing three new toilets. One urinal was beyond repair and has been sealed off.

The good news is that both washrooms are now working. The bad news is that the water pipes inside the walls are galvanized steel and badly corroded. We do not know the extent of the problem. We are therefore looking at a major project to identify and replace all of the galvanized water pipes in the Church and rectory.

Once the fundamental plumbing issues are resolved, we will have to renovate the two washrooms. It may not be possible to make the washrooms larger, but they will be clean and modern. The kitchen is another story.

It is important that we maintain our Church as a worthy place of worship. Thank you for your continued donations to our Parish Renovation Fund.
