FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Getting Things Right Matters

I have spent more years in school than I care to think about, capping it off with a Ph.D. — or, as I prefer to call it, a 'black belt' — in Engineering. I worked for many years as a Structural Engineer designing paper mills, powers plants, etc., before discerning my call to the priesthood. When I sat down with the vocations director, he informed me that I would be spending five more years in school. As a bonus I do have two more diplomas to hang on my wall, a BST and an M.Div., i.e., *Bachelor of Sacred Theology* and *Master of Divinity* — 'divinity' is an old-fashioned term for theology. I guess that gives me the right to call myself a 'theologian'.

One of the peculiar things about the Seminary courses is the marking scheme. In Engineering school, if you answer all the questions on an exam correctly you get 100%. In Seminary, an excellent essay only gets a mark of 85%. In Engineering, brilliance is not required; you just need to be competent, knowing how to get the right answers.

Pope Benedict, at the start of the conclave that would elect him to succeed Pope John Paul II, warned against the idea that theology is only a matter of opinion or one's personal point of view.

Today, having a clear faith based on the Creed of the Church is often labeled as 'fundamentalism'. Whereas relativism, that is, letting oneself be 'tossed here and there, carried about by every wind of doctrine', seems the only attitude that can cope with modern times. We are building a *dictatorship of relativism* that does not recognize anything as definitive and whose ultimate goal consists solely of one's own ego and desires.

My engineer's mind revolts at the idea that 'there are no right answers.' In one seminary essay I quoted St. Thomas Aquinas. The prof wrote in the margin, "I want to know what *you think*!" What I think is that Aquinas is right. For Aquinas, theology is not about what *you think*, but "how the truth of things stands."

As Denys Turner wrote in his 'portrait' of Aquinas: For St. Thomas, theology is a true *disciplne*: it has a teachable curriculum; it requires training in specific skills you can acquire and carry about with you; it covers a defined range of issues and texts that are studied over a fixed period; it carries a standard bibliography of authorities; and you can examine students so as to test how good they are at it — you can pass or fail them.

In other words, Theology is like Engineering: there are right answers and wrong answers. In Canada, engineers wear an 'iron ring' on their little finger. The story is that the original rings were made of iron from the Quebec Bridge, which collapsed during construction, causing 88 deaths. The ring is a constant reminder that getting things right matters.
