The Enduring Message of Fatima.

"God wishes to establish in the world devotion to My Immaculate Heart. If what I say to you is done, many souls will be saved and there will be peace. ...In the end, My Immaculate Heart will triumph."

God wished to convey this message through Fatima's apparitions: When all else seems to fail, turn to Our Lady! The Fatima apparitions came at an unexpected time and place: Fatima, Portugal. While Portugal was a long-time Catholic nation, at the time of the apparitions, the Catholic religion was looked down upon and suppressed by the government in favour of secularism to have a "modern state" free from religion.

Given the circumstances, the apparitions had the potential to impact Portugal's religious landscape significantly. An apparition to the nation's Church officials and elected officials could have been a powerful catalyst in returning the hearts of the people to God, potentially reversing the trend of religious suppression and secularism. And yet, Our Lady did not appear to those of influence, or anyone in the city, for that matter. Instead, to three little children in a small village near Fatima, on "the 13th of May in the Cova da Iria, appeared oh so brilliant the virgin Maria!" It is usual for God to be in the "unexpected" and always unusual for us to find God where we least expect Him! As a wise priest once told me, 'God will use even the most unusual circumstances for our sanctification'!

The apparitions of Fatima revealed that God wished to draw people to Himself through Mary, specifically, her immaculate heart. Mary at Fatima implored many times to pray the rosary (daily)! The rosary is not simply a recitation of a repetition of prayers, but as St. John Paul II writes in his encyclical *Rosarium Virginis Mariae*, for the rosary:

Has all the depth of the Gospel message in its entirety. With the Rosary, the Christian people *sits at the school of Mary* and is led to contemplate the beauty on the face of Christ and to experience the depths of his love.

As we celebrate the Feast of Fatima, our parochial feast, let us call to mind this aspect of Our Lady as the "way of the lost" that leads us to her Son. There are times when we can look at the world and our own lives, and it would appear that we are sailing on troubled, "unusual" seas with no hope of shore in sight. When this is the case, we have only to look to Our Blessed Mother, the *Stella Maris*, the star of the sea, and just as the stars guide the sailors, so too will Our Blessed Mother guide us through the dark of the storm to the dawn of the Son, to when we will rest securely in the safe ports of heaven. This is the mission of Mary: to lead us to Christ, just as she leads the servants to Him at Cana, *Quodcumque dixerit vobis, facite*, "Do whatever he tells you" (Jn. 2.5).
