FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

The Church of St. Irenaeus

The Church, though scattered throughout the whole world, even to the ends of the earth, having received the faith from the apostles and their disciples, guards it with care, as dwelling in but a single house, and similarly believes as if having but one soul and a single heart, and preaches, teaches and hands on this faith with a unanimous voice, as if possessing only one mouth. For though languages differ throughout the world, the content of the Tradition is one and the same. The Churches established in Germany have no other faith or Tradition, nor do those of the Iberians, nor those of the Celts, nor those of the East, of Egypt, of Libya, nor those established at the centre of the world. The Church's message is true and solid, in which one and the same way of salvation appears throughout the whole world. — St. Irenaeus, guoted in the Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 173.

Most 'ordinary' Catholics are only vaguely aware of the current controversies in the Church; and this is probably for the best. For most of us, it is enough to remain faithful to the Gospel and, as St. Paul says, "continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling."

Controversies come and go; they are like the great storm that threatened to drown Jesus' disciples as they were crossing the Sea of Galilee. The disciples, seeing Jesus asleep in the stern, cried out: "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?" The Lord, having calmed the storm, said to them: "Why are you afraid? Do you still have no faith?"

Every age has its own controversies. At the time of Irenaeus, the Church was threatened by Gnosticism. Irenaeus' *Against Heresies* is not an easy read. There are beautiful passages on the Catholic faith, but most of the book is devoted to describing the beliefs of the Gnostics, which seemed convincing to many people in the 2nd century, but today are simply weird.

If you read 'current trends in theology' from the 1960's you get the same feeling. How was this ever convincing? Yet, it was seen as cutting edge sixty years ago.

Today we are dealing with a new set of challenges. For example, we are now supposed to accept a 'new theology of blessings' which allows for the blessing of same-sex couples. The 'old' theology considers such blessings antithetical to the Christian faith, as indeed they are.

In every age there are those within the Church who want the Church to accommodate itself to the Spirit of the Age, the *Zeitgeist*. It may appear that they are succeeding in their efforts at 'modernization' but in time the Church will revert to her true nature. She remains the Church of St. Irenaeus, St. Athanasius, St. Augustine, and St. Thomas Aquinas, St. Teresa of Avila, etc.
