FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Getting off to a fresh start

If sometimes it seems that our progress is slow, it is still better to crawl along the right road then to make great strides off the road. As long as we keep moving in the right direction, we will eventually reach our destination. — St. Augustine

It seemed that the summer had only just started, and now here we are already at Labour Day and the beginning of a new school year. This is my first summer since my Mother died and I miss my frequent visits with her in Ottawa.

The summer has been mostly uneventful, except for the flood in the chapel during that heavy rain storm in July. The insurance company is repairing the damage to the chapel ceiling. The main roof of the church was replaced a few years ago. Now we need to replace the roofs of the chapel, office and rectory. This will be an expensive project, but one that we cannot put off any longer.

We still need to organize a Building Committee to begin planning the renovation of the Church Hall washrooms and kitchen. This falls under the category 'necessary by not urgent.' We also need a Kitchen-Users Group for the upkeep of the kitchen and determining future needs.

A lot of my time this summer was spent updating our Volunteer Screening Files. So far only a third of our volunteers have been through the volunteer training. This training is an important part of the screening process. It only has to be done once, so I hope that (if you have not yet taken the training) you will avail yourself of the next opportunity.

Finally, one of the things that I most look forward to each summer is 'Edge' Camp. Edge is youth ministry for children in grades 6 to 8. Each year, since 2009, the participating parishes organize a five-day summer camp at Camp White Pine near Haliburton. The camp staff provides the usual camp activities during the day (swimming, canoeing, climbing, etc.) and the youth ministers provide catechesis in the evening. There is Mass every day, with a day for Confessions. I have been attending with my former parish since 2010.

When I was at camp this year, I had a chance to talk with the deputy director of the Office of Catholic Youth for the Archdiocese of Toronto. We discussed how we might get youth ministry started in this parish. It will require a dedicated core of parent volunteers, but it is doable if we are firmly resolved to make it happen. The Archdiocese can provide the necessary training. My goal is to attend Edge Camp next summer not with my *former* parish, but with my *current* parish.

The parish year essentially runs parallel with the school year, so we are now getting off to a fresh start. I did not accomplish all that I hoped to get done this summer, but we are moving in the right direction.
