FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Saints' days

Soon after arriving in Ottawa I located a favorite geographical reference point to which I would often go to ponder the state of the world and the Church. It was the rocky promontory of Nepean Point on which stands the grand statue of Samuel de Champlain looking westward over the Ottawa River. When the French first charted this river they named each rapids and waterfall after a saint, in the order they occur in the Litany of the Saints. The voyageurs' difficult river journey was thus converted into a litany of water and stone that reinforced in each voyageur the courage needed to go on. — James W. Demers, *The Last Roman Catholic?*

During the Easter Vigil Mass, the Litany of the Saints is intoned as those who are to be baptized proceed to the baptismal font. (The *Kyrie* that we use on weekdays is taken from the beginning of the Litany). The Litany is a relatively short list of Saints, representative of different categories: Apostles, martyrs, doctors of the Church, founders of religious orders, holy men and women. These saints are invoked as examples of faith to encourage the newly baptized. As the author of the Letter to the Hebrews writes: "Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight and the sin that clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us."

Those who only attend Mass on Sunday are unaware that weekday Mass, more often than not, is celebrated in honor of a particular Saint. As the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal* states:

In the cycle of the year, as she celebrates the Mystery of Christ, the Church also proposes to the devotion of the faithful the Memorials of the Martyrs and other Saints. The Saints who have universal importance are celebrated in an obligatory way throughout the whole Church; other Saints are either inscribed in the calendar, but for optional celebration, or are left to be honored by a particular Church, or nation, or religious family.

The month of October, besides being dedicated to the Rosary, is a great month for Saints! It starts off with the feast day of 'the little flower', St. Therese of Lisieux, and also includes such familiar Saints as Francis of Assisi, Teresa of Avila, Margaret Mary Alacoque, Marguerite d'Youville, and Ignatius of Antioch. These Saints ought to be known much better than they are. Each of them, in their own way, is a model of Christian faith in action.

Like the voyageurs' naming of rapids and waterfalls along the Ottawa River, the memorials of the Saints convert the whole year into a litany that reinforces in each of us the courage needed to go on in our Christian journey.
