FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

The Stations of the Cross

Lord Jesus, as we walk with you along the Way of the Cross, grant that it may not be just a moment of passing piety. Help us to accompany you not only with noble thoughts, but with all our hearts and in every step we take each day of our lives. Help us to resolutely set out on your path. Free us from fear of the Cross, from the fear that our life may escape our grasp unless we cling possessively to everything it has to offer. Help us to unmask all those temptations that promise life, but whose enticements in the end leave us only empty and deluded. Help us to discover the path of love that gives us true life and life in abundance. — Pope Benedict XVI, Way of the Cross.

I cannot imagine going through Lent without doing the Stations of the Cross each Friday evening. When we think of that day, two thousand years ago, when Jesus made his way from the Praetorium to Calvary, collapsing under the weight of his cross, do we not wish that we had been there to console him? The Stations of the Cross is a powerful communal prayer in which we unite ourselves to Christ in his suffering. Like the Rosary, it is a beloved devotion of the Christian faithful going back many centuries.

Each year on Good Friday the Pope leads the Way of the Cross in the Roman Colosseum, the site of so many martyrdoms. I especially appreciate the meditations of Pope John Paul II on that day in 2003. In his mediation on the third station, Jesus falls for the first time, he says:

Jesus falls under the weight of the Cross. He does not resort to his superhuman powers or the power of the angels. Those who saw him when he showed his power over human infirmities and even death itself, may well, in their grief, have wondered: "What now? Is he repudiating all that?" The crowd would yell: "He saved others but he cannot save himself." He accepts these provocations for he is determined not to combat them. To be insulted is what he wills. To stagger and fall under the weight of Cross is what he wills. To the end, down to the bitter end, he is faithful to what he had said: "Not my will, but yours be done". God will bring forth the salvation of humanity from Christ's falling beneath the weight of the Cross.

If we are to truly enter into the spirit of Lent, we must accompany Jesus along the *via crucis* and contemplate the mystery of the Cross. As Cardinal Sarah has written:

The Cross is the center of the world, the place where our stability is anchored. Everything else is unstable, changing, and uncertain. Calvary is the highest point in the world, from which we can see everything with new eyes: the eyes of faith and love, the eyes of a child, the eyes of God.


