

### FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Our Lady of Fatima.

We suddenly saw what seemed to be a flash of lightning. "We'd better go home," I said to my cousins. We began to go down the slope when we saw on a holm oak a lady dressed all in white, brighter than the sun and radiating light more clear and intense than a crystal glass filled with sparkling water when the rays of the sun shine through it. She said, "Do not be afraid. I will do you no harm." I asked, "Where are you from." She replied, "I am from heaven." — Lucia dos Santos

Several years ago a friend visited Fatima, Portugal and brought me back a Rosary from the shrine. This became my most used set of beads. It seemed providential when I was assigned to this Parish.

There of many instances of Mary showing herself to the faithful. The most notable of these are Guadalupe, Lourdes and Fatima. Each of these 'Marian apparitions' was accompanied by a miraculous sign: the image on the tilma, the spring of water, the miracle of the sun. Not only have these apparitions been approved by the Church and assigned feast days, but those to whom Mary appeared have been declared Saints: Juan Diego, Bernadette, Francisco and Jacinta. Much has been made of the 'messages' or 'secrets' associated with these appearances, but the essential message in each case is quite simple: a call to conversion and prayer.

The two younger children of Fatima, Francisco and Jacinta Marto, did not live long after seeing Our Lady in 1917. Francisco died in 1919 and Jacinta in 1920. Their joint feast day in the Church's calendar is 20 February, the anniversary of Jacinta's death. Lucia became a nun with the Sisters of St. Dorothy but later she transferred to the Discalced Carmelites. Lucia died in 2005 at the age of 97. Her case for sainthood is in progress.

The miracle of the sun is dismissed by skeptics as a fiction, despite having been seen by thousands of people. After all, it is impossible for the sun to move about in the sky. Fr. Stanley Jaki, priest and physicist, offers a rational explanation that respects the accounts of the eyewitnesses. He concludes that the cause was an 'ice lens' in the upper atmosphere which refracted the light from the sun. Such ice lenses do form but are exceedingly rare.

That the 'dancing' of the sun in the sky can be attributed to natural causes does not lessen the significance of the event. That such a rare event occurred on the very day that thousands had gathered at the Cova da Iria to witness a promised 'sign' from the Virgin Mary is a miracle in itself. As Fr. Jaki writes, "In producing miracles God often makes use of natural causes, but enhances their physical components and their interactions. One can indeed say that the Mother of God played with the rays of the sun at that extraordinary hour at Fatima."
