FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

The intercession of the Saints.

I have forbidden St. Philomena to work miracles here on behalf of the body. She may cure souls to her hearts content, but she must heal bodies elsewhere!

— St. John Vianney, the Curé of Ars.

In his little parish Church, in the remote village of Ars, St. John Vianney dedicated an altar to St. Philomena. When visitors experienced miraculous healings the Curé always gave credit to St. Philomena, whom he called his 'dear little saint.' His biographer tells us that "he attributed to her all the marvels that were being accomplished, and he took delight in proclaiming them. Thanks to him, devotion to the youthful saint spread all over France." He said, "I do not work miracles. I am but a poor ignorant man who once tended sheep. Address yourselves to St. Philomena."

Catholics are known for their recourse to the intercession of the Saints. The Catechism (2683) states:

Saints share in the living tradition of prayer by the example of their lives, the transmission of their writings, and their prayer today. They contemplate God, praise him, and constantly care for those whom they have left on earth. When they entered into the joy of their Master, they were 'put in charge of many things.' Their intercession is their most exalted service in God's plan. We can and should ask them to intercede for us and for the whole world.

The Saints that I am most drawn to — Augustine, Teresa of Avila, Francis de Sales — are distinguished for their holiness of life and the brilliance of their teaching. I look to them for wisdom, not for miracles. I regard Mother Angelica as an un-canonized Saint. She did not perform miracles, but she was constantly the receiver of them. She brought innumerable people back to the faith. She may not have healed any bodies, but she saved many souls.

Frankly, I have always found the business of attributing miracles to prospective saints rather sketchy. Little Johnny is sick and all the family and friends pray to blessed *Santo Subito*, and behold there is a miraculous cure! Nonna, meanwhile, has been lighting candles to the Virgin, calling on Padre Pio, and doing non-stop novenas to a whole roster of her Saints, Whose pull with God actually did the trick? My money would be on Nonna herself!

Putting skepticism aside, there is some logic to the process. What it demonstrates is a real 'devotion' to the potential saint. This person is considered holy, so much so that his intercession is sought in preference to Nonna's Saints. We know that only God can perform miracles, but God glorifies the Saints by making them co-operators in his saving work. In calling on the Saints we are not ignoring God, but uniting ourselves with those whom he loves, be it the saintly Curé of Ars, or his 'dear little saint' Philomena.
