FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Lectionary envy.

I warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: if anyone adds to them, God will add to him the plagues described in this book, and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God will take away his share in the tree of life and in the holy city, which are described in this book. — Revelation 22:18

St. John's warning at the end of the Book of Revelation applies equally to the other seventy-two books of the Bible. God's revelation in Sacred Scripture is the foundation of our faith. St. Jerome famously said, "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ." Since few people can read the Bible in its original languages, it is essential that we have accurate translations of the Bible. This is all the more important for the readings of Scripture at Mass and in the Divine Office.

It is not often that Bishops' Conferences make good decisions, but the Catholic Church in England has adopted a new translation for their Lectionary, and surprisingly they have chosen the English Standard Version, Catholic Edition (ESV-CE) with the Abbey Psalms. The ESV is an excellent translation of the Bible. It is based on the Revised Standard Version (RSV) which itself is a modernization of the venerable King James Bible (known as the 'authorized' or 'standard' version). It was developed by Crossway, an evangelical Protestant publisher, and first published in 2001. Tens of millions of copies have been sold.

Regrettably, our Lectionary in Canada, now and for the foreseeable, is based on the New Revised Standard Version (NRSV), also an update of the RSV. It has scholarly pretensions but what sets it apart is its relentless use of 'inclusive language.' To be fair, the most egregious inclusivisms have been corrected in the current edition of Sunday Lectionary published in 2008. We are still waiting for the publication of the revised Weekday Lectionary. My question is: instead of re-editing the NRSV to remove its most salient feature, inclusive language, why not simply use the ESV which is in fact a scholarly update of the RSV?

Looking at today's reading from Sirach, there is a curious difference between the English and Canadian Lectionaries. Today we will hear: "The prayer of the humble pierces the clouds and **it** will not **rest** until it reaches its **goal**." In England they hear: "The prayer of the humble pierces the clouds, and **he** will not be **consoled** until it reaches the **Lord**." The difference is not due to inclusive language, but due to the habit of the NRSV editors of avoiding traditional interpretations. I have looked at the original Greek and the Vulgate, and the ESV agrees with both. Perhaps it is no big deal, but I prefer the more faithful translation of Scripture. Envy is a sin. *Mea culpa* I envy the English people their ESV Lectionary.
