#### FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

*The rest of the story.* 

The knot of Eve's disobedience was undone by the obedience of Mary. For what the virgin Eve had bound fast through unbelief, the virgin Mary set free through faith. Just as the human race fell into bondage to death by means of a virgin, so it was rescued by a virgin. — St. Irenaeus

Evangelical Protestants have a problem with Mary. Let me rephrase that: Mary is a problem for Evangelicals. They really do not know what to make of her. When they think of her at all they depict her as an ordinary village girl chosen, almost at random, to be a kind of 'surrogate mother' or 'rent-a-womb.' According to the *Dictionary of the Later New Testament* by InterVarsity Press:

Early Christians devoted their energies to proclaiming Christ and his cross. Mary is essentially acknowledged as one of God's instruments in carrying out his plan of salvation. Despite Mary's unique relationship with Jesus, he is not her son but the Son of God. The identification of Mary as an exalted figure in the church belongs to a later development.

Certainly, when the Apostles set out on their missionary journeys they focused on the *kerygma* (from Greek *keryx*, herald), the initial proclamation of the Gospel. As St. Paul says to the Corinthians: "For I decided to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ and him crucified. For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures." This initial proclamation of Christ is the necessary foundation and beginning of our faith. It is 'of first importance', but it is not the fullness of the faith.

Once a person is convinced that Christ is God incarnate, other questions will naturally arise. It is then appropriate to consider other aspects of the faith, including the unique role of Mary, whom Gabriel greeted as *kecharitomene* (from Greek *charis*, grace), endued with grace; who was told by Simeon, "And a sword shall pierce your own soul too"; who, at the wedding at Cana, instructed the servants, "Do whatever he tells you"; who stood at the foot of the Cross; whom the Book of Revelation reveals as "a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars."

We are living in a culture where most of our neighbors are strangers to Christ. Evangelicals love the Lord and they love the Bible. St. Paul said, "In every way Christ is proclaimed and in that I rejoice." The initial proclamation, the *kerygma*, is necessary but evangelization cannot stop there. Understanding the role of Mary is not a 'later development,' it is 'the rest of the story.'
