FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Heart speaks to heart.

When I think about what I am going to say to you, the 'word' or message is already in my heart. I look for a way to speak this so that the word in my heart may also find place in yours. The sound of my voice brings the meaning of the word to you and then passes away. The word which the sound has brought to you is now in your heart, and yet it is still also in mine. — St. Augustine

As we prepare to celebrate the Nativity of the Lord, we should pause to reflect on those awesome words at the beginning of St. John's Gospel which we will hear at Mass on Christmas morning: "And the Word (*Logos*) became flesh and dwelt among us." John uses the Greek word *logos*, which is not 'word' in the grammatical sense, but the interior word of the heart.

When John Henry Newman (now Saint, and Doctor of the Church) was made a Cardinal he chose as his motto, 'Cor ad cor loquitur — Heart speaks to heart.' He took this from Augustine's commentary on the Gospel of John. A word that proceeds from the lips stops at the ear, but a word that proceeds from the heart does not stop until it reaches another heart.

Jesus is the 'word' in the heart of the Father. All of the created universe came into existence through this Word: "Fiat lux — Let there be light!" It is also by means of a word that the Son of God enters the world. The Angel Gabriel announces to Mary: "Behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son." But this word is not accomplished without Mary's word, her Fiat — "Let it be to me according to your word." St. Bernard of Clairvaux, contemplating this moment, prays to Mary:

Answer quickly, O Virgin. Reply in haste to the Angel of the Lord. Answer with a word, and receive the Word of God. Speak your own word, and conceive the divine Word. Breathe a passing word, and embrace the eternal Word.

The Word, from the heart of the Holy Trinity, speaks to Mary's heart, and Mary responds with a word from her own heart. Mary is known by many titles, but in this Christmas season we honor her as *Alma Redemptoris Mater*, the loving Mother of our Redeemer. The Son of God chose to take his human nature from this young woman and from no other. He willed that her heart should forever be united with his.

Christmas is often described as a 'magical' time, but the proper word is 'mystical,' because heaven touches earth. The Word, who existed eternally before all ages, who for nine months has dwelt secretly in Mary's womb, now enters the world. A baby boy wrapped in swaddling clothes is cradled in his mother's arms. And there in the silence of the stable in Bethlehem, wordlessly, heart speaks to heart.

Closing of the Year of Jubilee 2025


