Guest post by Br. Andrew Edirimanasinghe:

Entrance Antiphon for Corpus Christi.

He fed them with the finest wheat: and filled them with honey from the rock – Psalm 81:16

This Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, a feast dedicated to the real presence of the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Our Lord in the Eucharist.

Reflecting on the Entrance Antiphon from Psalm 81, we see God’s providence revealed through nourishment: He feeds His people with the “finest wheat” and satisfies them with “honey from the rock.” Honey, known for its healing and preserving qualities, becomes a fitting image of incorruption and enduring life, while the “rock” in Scripture signifies firmness, fortitude, and the unshakable foundation of faith—pointing ultimately to God Himself, from whom the sweetness of eternal life flows.

This “honey from the rock” finds its fullest meaning in Christ Himself — the true Rock struck on Calvary, from whose pierced side flowed the fountain of the Church’s sacramental life and the sweetness of eternal salvation. At every Holy Mass, the sacrifice of Calvary is made present once more, and the faithful are fed with the “finest wheat,” the true Bread come down from heaven. Our Lord makes this clear in John 6: “I am the bread of life ... the living bread that came down from heaven, if anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever.”

If we truly believe that Christ Himself is present upon the altar, then churches should reflect this sacred reality. The ancient principle lex orandi, lex credendi — the law of prayer is the law of belief — reminds us that the way we worship shapes what we believe. The sacred liturgy is meant to form a spirit of recollection, reverence, and awe before the altar of God. Prayerful silence, dignified worship, and reverent music lift the soul toward God and dispose our hearts to recognize the mystery being celebrated. In contrast, anything that distracts from that sacred focus obscures the encounter with the living Christ. As Cardinal Robert Sarah said, “The liturgy is not a place for chatting, meeting, or making noise. It is the place of adoration, where God acts, and man adores.”

The Eucharist is too sacred to be treated casually, and too precious to be approached without awe. Holy Communion is an encounter with the living God, deserving our deepest reverence in both heart and gesture. The manner of reception should reflect faith in what is received: humility before Majesty, adoration before the King of Kings. External gestures of reverence are not empty customs; they are visible confessions of belief. In an age that has grown casual before the sacred, the Church calls us back to Eucharistic awe — to kneeling hearts, humble adoration, and reverent reception of Our Lord.
