FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Integral human development.

I am aware that nowadays documents issued by the Pope do not arouse the same interest as in the past and that they are quickly forgotten. — Pope Francis, Evangelii Gaudium

Pope Leo has just issued his first encyclical, Magnifica Humanitas — “On Safeguarding the Human Person in the Time of Artificial Intelligence (AI).” It can be summed up in a few words: ‘AI is a powerful tool that can be used for good or evil; don’t be evil.’

Concern about the ethics of AI is certainly a topical issue and, to a certain extent, the Pope is recognized as a voice of moral authority. But I doubt that those who are developing and implementing AI are paying much attention. The power of this new technology is simply too great not to be used. And the profits to be made are too great not to be pocketed.

Reading this encyclical, I am reminded of a controversial little book (Surnaturel) published in 1946 by Fr. Henri de Lubac. He argued against the idea that God might have created man in a state of ‘pure nature’ in which the ultimate goal of human life was natural happiness, with no reference to God. This idea now seems to have taken hold within the Church under the rubric of ‘integral human development.’

As Pope Leo puts it in his encyclical:

We [the Church] can diligently contribute to every initiative that builds a more just world, and we can call others to collaborate in promoting the integral development of every human being. We wish to engage in dialogue with all men and women of our time, with whom we share in the events, questions, and aspirations of humanity. Together with them, we seek to identify new paths for the common good and for promoting a dignified life for all.

In other words, the Church seeks to cooperate with people of all faiths and none to build a better world for all, without the intrusion of religion. By working together, we can address the urgent crises of global warming, migration, and AI. Meanwhile the sticky issues of abortion and euthanasia, while not being ignored, can be put to one side as “choices that the Church considers gravely wrong.”

Perhaps I am being overly critical, but the Western world is in a spiritual death spiral. The Churches are empty. Are we in the business of fostering the development of human potential or proclaiming the Gospel?

Pope John Paul II called for a ‘new evangelization.’ At the turn of the millennium he issued Novo Millennio Ineunte in which he set out a roadmap for the Church in the coming century. In my first homily in this parish I called it our ‘mission statement.’ It provides the standard against which our progress is measured. Sadly, it now seems to have been entirely forgotten quasi non erat, as if it had never been.
