FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

We must never give up the fight.

Every truly just society is built upon the recognition of the dignity of the human person. If life ceases to be recognized as a fundamental value, what future can our societies have? Can a community that casts into the shadows the unborn child, the elderly, the sick, be called fully just? The defense of human life is neither a partisan issue nor a religious interest: it is a goal of civilization. Every human life must be safeguarded from conception to its natural end. The moral greatness of a nation is manifested, above all, in its capacity to protect those lives that are most fragile. — Pope Leo XIV, *Address to the Spanish Parliament*

On his recent trip to Spain, Pope Leo began his speech to the nation's lawmakers with a question: "What conception of the human person inspires laws, and what kind of society do those laws build?"

Modern Popes speak so often on so many topics that most of what they say is predictable. In contrast, Leo's address to the Spanish parliament is shocking in his direct denunciation of what Pope John Paul II called 'the culture of death.'

Thirty years ago, in his encyclical *Evangelium Vitae* (The Gospel of Life), Pope John Paul II urgently warned about the growing acceptance of abortion and euthanasia:

A new cultural climate is developing which gives crimes against life a new and even more sinister character. Broad sectors of public opinion justify crimes against life in the name of the rights of individual freedom, and on this basis they claim not only exemption from punishment but even authorization by the State, so that these things can be done with total freedom and indeed with the free assistance of health-care systems.

It is encouraging, therefore, to see Pope Leo standing up boldly for the right to life.

As Pope Benedict wrote:

Widespread sections of public opinion may find it downright distasteful for us to continue to remind them that respect for the child in the womb is a decisive question. Should we not consider this debate settled? Why not accept that we have lost this battle and instead choose to dedicate our energies to initiatives that find support in a broader social consensus? After all, much in our private lives seems to be going on as before. Let me respond with the stupendous words of the ancient *Letter to Diognetus*, which describes the absolutely essential mission of Christians in the world: "Christians are in the world what the soul is in the body. God has assigned us such a high position, and we are not allowed to abandon it."

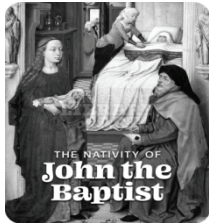

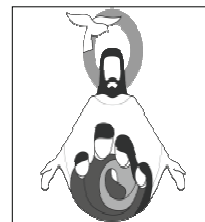
All proceeds will go directly toward the parish roofing fund,
